The Central Western Zone (CWZ) of the New York State Retired Teachers' Association (NYSRTA) is pleased to announce that grants will be available to full-time employed educational professionals possessing a Bachelor's Degree who are pursuing permanent certification, a certificate of advanced study or an advanced degree in any educational field.

Eligibility:
